

MTA TITLES COMMISSION

Process.

Promoters submit a title for state/national/international application to their state representatives.

State Title

If the state has an incorporated body and a functioning board. They decide on the state title. It is then submitted to the MTA Gen Sec. The Gen Sec will review it for policy. If any of the policy is not followed, it may be overturned by the Gen Sec. If any policy is not followed an argument as to why give an exemption must be presented.

If the state/territory does not have a functioning board and is not incorporated. The state representative forwards the application on to the Titles Commission for approval. The State representative must give a recommendation regarding the title and ensure all policies and procedures are followed.

National Title

All national titles are forwarded from the state rep to the titles commission for approval. They are then sent to the Gen Sec. The Gen Sec will review it for policy. If any of the policy is not followed, it may be overturned by the Gen Sec. If any policy is not followed an argument as to why give an exemption must be presented.

International Title

The state rep forwards the application to the Gen Sec for processing with the executive and international requirements.
